After another successful year of the programme, with exciting progress during the 3 training weekends, excellent county match scoring and 2 of the 14 members of the squad shooting for England in the Lawrence, the Lions are once again very much looking forward to the Imperial meeting.

The Management team are already starting to look forward to the 2019-20 cycle and will be welcoming applications in August.

The 1 year training cycle involves sessions on technical performance, training planning, psychology, team drills, match practice and wind reading – as well as opportunities to receive coaching and one-to-one mentoring from leading English elite shooters.

Eligible candidates will be over the age of 18, have 1 or fewer caps for England and will have demonstrated clear ambition and progression of talent over the last year or two. Selection is based around recent individual and team performances (club, school, cadet unit and county) as well as the applicant's personal statement.
