Secretaries of English XX

Before the English XX Club was formed, there were secretaries of the English XX. The earliest mention occurs in a report of a meeting on 12 March 1866 to appoint a captain for the year. At the end of the meeting, Capt. Lockner (possibly Capt. C.P. Lochner) and Mr Winser, the honorary secretaries, were requested to continue their valuable services (see Volunteer Services Gazette 27 March 1866 p247). Mr Winser continued as honorary secretary until 1879 and perhaps longer.

This section lists those who have coached in the National or Mackinnon matches since 1945. National appearances are listed after a capital N, for example, N: 1946; Mackinnon appearances are listed after a capital M. Main coaches are denoted by a lower case m after the date.

The yearbook lists ten coaches for the National in 1946 and 1947, presumably two per target. From 1948 there were six coaches: a main coach and five sub-coaches.

In the Mackinnon there were four coaches: a main coach and three sub-coaches except for the following years:

- 1948, 1955-1968, 1961 and 1965 when there were three coaches
- 1949 to 1952 when there were five (with two on the left and right targets and one on the centre)
- 1959 when there were five (a main coach, assistant coach and three sub-coaches)
- 1963 when there were five (two coaches on the centre target with one on the left and right). This probably happened in 1962 and possibly 1953, 1954, and 1960.

Unfortunately the yearbook does not always list coaches and the photographs do not always identify them. Help from members would be appreciated, especially copies of the team lists, which were given to all team members with the captain's instructions for the match.

The number of reserves seems to have varied after the second World War. In the National it settled down to five from 1950, with as few as one recorded in 1947, and as many as eight in 1949 when the match was in Scotland.

In the Mackinnon there were usually four reserves up to 1951; from 1952 this dropped to three. It is likely that not all reserves from this period are known.
